

# **OLYMPIC COMMERATIVE POSTER by Caswell Native**

This poster won the North Carolina Poster Award for the 1987 U.S. Olympic Festival.

In 1987, The U.S. Olympic Festival was held in central North Carolina. Greensboro was the site for figure and speed skating. Durham held venues for track and field, soccer, and wrestling. Chapel Hill hosted basketball, gymnastics, and swimming. Caswell native and one of North Carolina's most important artists, painted the poster that was a key part of the festival's marketing.
